The Van Buren County Board of Supervisors met on this date at the Des Moines River bridge in Douds-Leando with the following present: Supervisors Meek, Nixon, Waugh, DOT District 5 engineer James Armstrong, and District 5 construction engineer James Webb.

Purpose of the meeting was to review and discuss issues regarding the construction of the new Des Moines River Bridge in Douds-Leando, approaches, and other issues regarding the eventual transfer of Highway 98 from the state to the county.

Issues discussed included the highway curve design on the north end of the bridge, curb and gutter on the south side of the bridge, creek erosion on the north end of the bridge, removal of the old bridge, sidewalk issues on the north end of the bridge, and other issues that the county requests resolution on before a transfer of jurisdiction takes place, including south abutment repair, concrete spillage on piers, and need for complete set of plans on Highway 98.

The meeting adjourned at 11:30AM.
