The Van Buren County Board of Supervisors met on this date at the courthouse with supervisors Meek, Nixon, and Waugh present. Minutes of the previous meeting were acknowledged.

Kris Rankin of the VBC SAFE Coalition was present to update the board on programs of the coalition.

On motion by Waugh, seconded by Nixon, the following request for rural tax abatement was approved: Michelle & Neil Philip, 33836 Hwy 2, Farmington (Parcel #000201601400445, Farmington Twp.). Ayes: 3

On motion by Waugh, seconded by Nixon, a renewal class C beer permit, including class B wine and Sunday sales, for Boyd Grocery, RR, Keosauqua. Ayes: 3

On motion by Nixon, seconded by Waugh, the following payroll/claims/reports were approved: Payroll-#15233-15308, Claims-#7859-7926, (Secondary Road-#25050-25086), VBC Ag extension treasurer bond/certificate of organization, Recorder-2nd Qrt. Ayes: 3

County Engineer Ryne Thornburg was present to update the board on the following projects including renaming of Hwy 98, 2019FY budget review, mechanic replacement, Pittsburg bridge repair, equipment status, E911 addressing, motor grader loan payoff.
