The Van Buren County Board of Supervisors met on this date at the courthouse with supervisors Meek, Nixon, and Waugh present.

On motion by Waugh, seconded by Nixon, a renewal Class C Beer/Class B Wine permit, including Sunday Sales, for the Douds Kwik Stop, Douds was approved. Ayes: 3

It is hereby noted that the 3rd and final reading of Van Buren County Ordinance No. 2013-2, Amendment #5, "Mt. Sterling Sewer Rate Ordinance" to read in its entirety was waived on motion by Nixon, seconded by Waugh. Ayes: 3. Following review of said ordinance and having received no written or oral comments from the public on the proposed ordinance, it was moved by Waugh, seconded by Nixon, that this 3rd reading of Van Buren County Ordinance No. 2013-2, Amendment #5, be acknowledged and approved.
