The Van Buren County Board of Supervisors met on this date at the courthouse with supervisors Meek, Nixon, Waugh, and deputy county auditor Lisa Plecker present.

On motion by Nixon, seconded by Waugh, upon recommendation of the county conservation board, Heather Butler, Croton, Iowa, was appointed as a PT Greef Store clerk, effective April 20, 2018, at a salary of \$8.45/hr. Ayes: 3

On motion by Waugh, seconded by Nixon, the following appointments were made to the Van Buren County Veterans Affairs Commission: Jammie Herring, Keosauqua-3 year term ending June 30, 2020, Sam Wenke, Bonaparte-3 year term ending June 30, 2021. Ayes: 3

On motion by Nixon, seconded by Waugh, the board approved and the chair was authorized to sign a services agreement with The Howard E. Nyhart Company, Inc. for GASB75 actuarial auditing services for the 2018FY and 2019FY. Ayes: 3
