The Van Buren County Board of Supervisors met for an emergency board meeting on this date at the courthouse with supervisors Meek and Waugh present. A conference call with Heartland Insurance Risk Pool attorney, Carl Salmons, was held beginning at 2:50 PM.

Following a conversation between Mr. Salmons and the 8th Judicial District Chief Judge Mary Ann Brown, it had been determined that there was good cause for the Van Buren County Board of Supervisors to immediately coordinate with the court system regarding several criminal court cases which had a hearing date set for July 17, 2018.
