The Van Buren County Courthouse offices will re-open to the public on June 1, 2020 with the following guidelines:

- Please refrain from entering the courthouse if you are ill or are experiencing fever, cough, or shortness of breath.
- Face coverings for customers are voluntary.
- When possible, persons doing business are encouraged to come to the courthouse alone.
- Out of respect for others, please practice social distancing while in the courthouse.
- The public health nurses will continue performing daily health screenings for all employees.
- Staff members will NOT be required to wear a mask.
- Staff members have increased their cleaning practices to maintain a healthy environment.
- Driver's license will be by appointment only, as it is also throughout the state. In the last couple months, the DOT has made many adjustments to try to continue to serve the needs of Iowa drivers, while observing the state guidelines for safe interactions. Many of those adjustments and additions have made it easier for drivers to accomplish their goals without leaving their homes. There are still several things that can't be done online, and of course, if you aren't comfortable doing your business online, we are here for you! All other treasurer's office business (taxes, motor vehicle licensing, etc.) will still be done as before, without appointment, but observing social distancing.
