By submitting this application to apply dust control the applicant agrees to the following conditions:

1. This application and payment shall be submitted before May 1st to give Van Buren County road crews sufficient time to prepare the road surface. Road preparation does not include placement of additional roadstone unless deemed necessary by your district blademan.
2. A copy of the application shall be submitted to the contractor applying dust control by the applicant.
3. The area where dust control is to be applied, must be flagged (flags are available from the engineer's office at no charge). Flags must be in place from May 1st to October 15th. It is the applicant's responsibility to keep the dust control location flagged.
4. Approved dust control materials include: Calcium Chloride, Magnesium Chloride, Lignin Sulfate or an approved combination of these products. Any other material must be approved on a case-by-case basis by the County Engineer.
5. The applicant is responsible for maintaining a suitable driving surface on the treated section of road. Failure to fill potholes will result in County road crews scarifying or blading the affected area to maintain the safety of the roadway.
6. Beginning October 15th normal blading operations will resume so road crews may prepare roads for winter.

Approximate Preparation and Dust Control Application Dates (These dates may vary based on road conditions):

April 30th	Permits due to Engineers Office
1st & 2nd Week of May	Roads prepared for first application
3rd & 4th Week of May	Vendors apply dust control
3rd & 4th Week of July	Roads prepared for second application
1st & 2nd Week of August	Vendors apply dust control second application
October 15th	Normal blading operations resume
